This program offers practical experience and skill development in public health communication and marketing. As a Health Communication and Marketing Fellow, you will have the opportunity to design a fellowship project tailored to your specific interests and career goals.

Responsibilities

You will be working on the following tasks and deliverables.

- **Project Development:** Identify a health communication or marketing project that aligns with your interests and the goals and mission of Let's Talk Public Health.
- **Project Execution:** Develop and implement a project plan that includes goals, deliverables, due dates, research, and content creation.
- **Project Dissemination:** Develop dissemination strategies to share your project via Let's Talk Public Health's channels, including social media, blogs, and presentations.
- **Collaboration:** Partner with the CEO to access knowledge, resources, and best practices.

Potential Projects

Here are potential health communication and marketing projects that you could work on.

- **Digital Marketing Campaign:** Develop and execute a campaign to raise awareness of a public health issue (can include posters, videos, social media posts, radio ads, etc.).

- **Data, Digital, or Edutainment Story:** Create a story that incorporates health information, messages, and data in a visually and/or emotionally engaging manner to entertain viewers while influencing their health-related knowledge, attitudes, beliefs, behaviors, and outcomes.
- **Podcast Episode:** Produce a podcast episode featuring an interview with an expert(s) in health communication and public health.
- **YouTube Video:** Create a 3-5 minute video to share information about a public health issue.
- **Blog Series:** Create a series of blog posts to share information about a public health issue.
- **Evaluation Report:** Evaluate an existing health communication initiative to assess its effectiveness or impact.

Essential Work Attributes

You must have the following work attributes to succeed in this internship.

- **Independence and Self-Drive:** You must be able to complete assigned tasks and deliverables with minimal supervision and seek guidance and support when needed.
- **Proactivity:** You must manage your own work schedule and anticipate if you will have any issues meeting deadlines. You must also come to meetings prepared and ready.
- **Digital Competence:** You must be equipped with a reliable computer, high-speed internet connection, and necessary software/tools for virtual work. You must also be able to learn to use new tools and technology.
- **Attention to Detail:** You must always review all your work for typos, grammatical errors, and factual inaccuracies before submitting it.

You must have the following skills and qualifications to succeed in this internship.

- Be currently enrolled in or have graduated from (in the past 3 years) an undergraduate or graduate program at a university or college in the United States. *(required)*
- Be currently studying or working in public health. *(strongly preferred)*

- Have previous experience with content creation. *(strongly preferred)*
